

TWELVE QUALIFICATIONS TO BE A SALT MEMBER

1. You must be a Christian who is living the Christian life, constantly seeking to serve God in all areas.
2. You need to be TEACHABLE- willing to learn and make changes in your own personal life. This person must be able to be confronted and encouraged by God and other Christians.
3. You must be an EXAMPLE in Christian conduct and character, showing respect to authority figures and those around you. If you have a reputation of being disruptive or causing trouble, SALT is NOT for you!
4. You must be committed to be at every SALT meeting and SALT workday. *We will most likely meet 1-2 times every month (prob. Friday nights and Saturday days) If this becomes a problem and is unexcused you will be dropped from the SALT team.*
5. You must be committed to be at 75% of all Jr. high programs (Weekend Bible Study, T.N.L, monthly activities, camps, etc.).
6. You will be required to memorize selected verses before each meeting every month.
7. You will need to maintain a DAILY personal devotional (Journaling) and prayer time with God.
8. The length of this commitment is from September 2008 - June 2009.
9. You must be willing to work hard.
10. You must be in 8th grade.
11. You need to be willing to serve in any way possible, including "undesirable dirty work" (bathroom clean up, set up, tear down, work projects, etc.)
12. You will need to be approved by Kirk and the Junior High Staff to be accepted into the SALT group. After turning in your application you will be notified a week before the first meeting on whether or not you will be serving on SALT this year.
